

Brussels Griffon

This little dog has a harsh wiry coat. The body is kept short and the legs are slightly longer.

To achieve this look you can use a #2 guide comb on the body to blend into the longer leg hair. If your dog carries a lot of leg hair you can use a #3 or #4 for legs and tummy area.



Ears should be clipped with a clipper without a guide comb on it. Set the blade to the shortest setting. Take great care when clipping the ears and keep your fingers under the ears at all times to prevent cutting the ear.

Their little heads should look slightly rounded on top. You can use a #2 or #3 guide comb on the head and cheeks, leaving the beard a little longer. The beard can be trimmed with a scissors if desired.
